

CANCL MOVEMENT

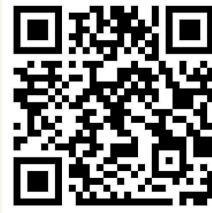

The ICANCL members have worked with the Government of India-Ministries of Women and Child Development (MWCD), Health & Family Welfare (MHFW), the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) and allied Government departments concerning legal aspects of child sexual abuse and juvenile justice.

The ICANCL Group was initiated at the IAP Conference in 1996 at Managalore. The theme of the conference was : "Child Rights :Our Concern". It was widely approved that paediatricians ought to take a comprehensive view of child care and address social determinants of health, well beyond the management of the sick child. Thus, the difficulties faced by children in socioeconomically underprivileged communities in our country need to be taken cognizance of and appropriately tackled by paediatricians.

Indian Child Abuse, Neglect and Child Labour (ICANCL) Group

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A large proportion of children remain deprived of proper health care, in nutrition and education. A large number of older children drop out of school, and are often employed in different forms of work. Child trafficking and child labour are serious child rights violations. Violence against children, exploitation and abuse, has significantly increased in children during and in the post COVID-19 pandemic.

The Indian CANCL group was registered nationally under the Societies Registration Act in 2010 (Registration number S 68745 of the year 2010), within the framework of Indian Academy of Pediatrics (IAP) (www.iapindia.org)



AIMS & OBJECTIVES

1. To advocate on behalf of rights of children, to inform and sensitise the civil society, obtain community participation and to formulate recommendations for welfare and protection of all children.
2. To reach out to the neglected and abused children to help to provide comprehensive care (health care, education, rehabilitation) in collaboration with national and international agencies.
3. To create social and community awareness through news media and information agencies to bring about social awareness, improve knowledge, attitudinal and behavioural change a toward the problems of underprivileged and vulnerable children and.
4. To impart knowledge, conduct training and education of medical doctors, paediatricians, allied multidisciplinary profesionas, frontline workers (ANM, Aanganwadi, ASHA), caregivers and parents through publications, CANCL news updates, webinars, seminars, workshops, regional, national and international conferences.
